Madhav University in Brief (2022-23)

Madhav University (MU) is constituted in the year 2014 as a State Private University through an Act (No. 07 of 2014) passed by the Rajasthan State Legislature, and it has received recognition from UGC under section 22 (Act of 1956). It was founded by the Manav Bharti Foundation. Dr. Raj Kumar, who chairs this foundation, has been working towards society's improvement for one decade. MU is situated in the rural and tribal area of Rajasthan, at "Madhav Hills," Banas River Bridge on National Highway-27 near the village Bharja in the Sirohi District of Rajasthan. MU is committed to expanding and sharing its knowledge base, prioritizing top-notch education through teaching, research, and community initiatives that address the needs of society. The university focuses on positively changing society by offering superior education in rural communities.

Madhav University aims to educate young people, including those from tribal regions, by implementing modern technologies, dependable and innovative ideas, excellent resources, and top-tier educators. It is dedicated to offering quality education in a variety of subjects and emphasizes strong research. The vision of the University is to establish a learning centre of academic and professional excellence at a global level for fulfilling the social, technological, business and well being needs of the society.

Presently University is offering Diploma, UG, PG and Ph D programs Faculty of Engineering And Technology, Faculty of Law, Faculty of Pharmacy, Faculty of Agriculture, Faculty of Commerce And Management, Faculty of Education, Faculty of Homoeopathy, Faculty of Allied Health Science, Faculty of Art And Science, Faculty of Naturopathy And Yoga. University courses are prior approved from the concerned regulatory bodies. Law courses are approved from the Bar Council of India, Pharmacy courses are approved from the Pharmacy council of India. Education & Physical Education courses are approved from the NCTE and ITI courses are approved from the NCVT. University is planning to start BHMS & BAMS courses with effect from the academic session 2018-19 and final permission is awaited from concerned council. The admission policy has been designed in accordance with the State Government /Regulatory Bodies rules.

The University has focused to meet the need and requirements of job-oriented education and facilities to the down trodden strata and rural youth of the Society with an emphasis on women in the region. During this short span, the University has constructed sufficient infrastructure etc to meet the academic requirements such as class-rooms, practical laboratories and Engineering

workshops. Infrastructure has been created, keeping in mind the regulatory body's requirements. Qualified faculty and experienced administrative staff have been appointed in the University. In the University more than 500 (Teaching & Non- Teaching Staff members) are employed.

Madhav University provides students with an education that not only focuses on their academic growth but also on their personal development, which includes their social, moral, and ethical values. The University prepares its students to be successful individuals with the necessary skills, understanding, attitudes, and hands-on experiences.

Every teacher and student at the University can now access the Internet effectively, thanks to over 500 connection points including Wi-Fi. Our University Library holds a collection of 65,000 books covering various topics and it subscribes to well-known National & International Journals. The library also offers access to online journals and software services, and we have set up thirty computers to serve as an e-library.

The Computer Centre provides short awareness programs for teachers and staff at no cost, which have proven helpful in encouraging them to use computer technology and other resources efficiently. The University has its own website that displays all types of information, forms, and details about events for the convenience of our students.

The university diligently updates its courses, introduces new ones, conducts research and adopts new policies to keep pace with rapid changes in technology, society and education. It provides hostels equipped with all necessary facilities for male and female students. Each hostel guarantees safety and has strict rules that do not disturb. Over the past three years, the university has also been running hospitals that offer Ayurvedic and Homeopathic treatments, including emergency services.

The University has established a training and placement cell. It also invites experienced lecturers from different industries to engage closely with students and for conducting on-campus job recruitments.

The university helps students grow by offering a gym with modern equipment, a yoga center, and both indoor and outdoor games. There's a playground and high-quality sports programs on campus. Besides these, students join in extra-curricular activities, like the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, with tasks led by coordinators and NSS Units I & II. They also take part in national sports contests held by the Association of Indian Universities. Before the academic year starts, new students meet at



welcome parties in their departments. Every year on September 25th, we celebrate University Foundation Day and hold a Youth Festival where students showcase their skills and are evaluated by appointed judges. To enhance their learning, we organize debates, seminars, and workshops. We also invite renowned teachers for special lectures.
