ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

VISION:

Establishing a learning center of academic and professional excellence on a global scale to fulfill the societal, technological, business, and well-being needs of society.

MISSION:

To empower youth academically, professionally, and ethically, particularly rural youth, utilizing state-of-the-art technology/systems, proven and innovative concepts, outstanding infrastructure, internationally recognized facilitators, and disseminating quality education across multidisciplinary fields with a special focus on research and innovation for future advancements.

Madhav University is a premier institution of higher learning in Rajasthan. Established in 2013 as a multi-disciplinary State Private University by Rajasthan Govt. Ordinance No. 29, it was duly approved by the State Legislature Act No. 07 of 2014 and notified and approved by UGC under section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956. The university offers education and research programs in diverse fields including Agriculture, Allied Health Sciences, Basic & Applied Sciences, Commerce and Management, Education and Physical Education, Engineering and Technology, Medical Sciences (BHMS), Humanities and Social Sciences, Law, and Pharmaceutical Sciences. Before starting any course, necessary approval from regulatory bodies such as Pharmacy Council of India, Bar Council of India, National Council for Teacher Education, National Commission for Homoeopathy, and RCI is sought. The university has a sprawling green campus spread over more than 150 Bighas.

Presently, students from all over India and abroad are studying at the university. Highly experienced and qualified faculty members, who form the backbone of the university, continuously engage in maintaining and enhancing a student-centric learning environment through innovative pedagogy. MU has implemented the Learning Outcome Based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) as per National Education Policy-2020 to enhance the knowledge, employability, skills, cultural, and ethical values of students. One measure of its reputation is the high quality of research produced in traditional and modern disciplines. In sports and cultural achievements, Madhav University is the leading institution in the state. The university's students have showcased their talent in sports by winning medals at the national level.

The university offers various facilities to its students, including separate hostel facilities for girls and boys, air-conditioned accommodations for international students, a central library along with departmental libraries, a reading space for 500 students, smart classrooms, online resources, video conferencing rooms, language labs, auditoriums, health centers providing homoeopathic, physiotherapy, and paramedical treatment, shopping complexes, ATMs, and sports and cultural activities facilities. Additionally, the university has established a school for differently-abled students, named "Madhav Special School for CWSN & Rehabilitation Centre," equipped with all necessary facilities such as lifts, ramps, toilets, wheelchairs, special vans, and caregivers, as per norms required for differently-abled persons.

Data of all graduating students has been uploaded to the National Academic Depository (NAD Portal). As of the 5th Convocation held on 09.10.2023, the university has produced approximately 233 Ph.D. graduates in different disciplines, with over 400 students currently registered for research under the guidance of qualified faculty members. Madhav University is widely recognized for its dedication to providing quality education and fostering excellent research.

Additionally, the University has established air-conditioned hostel facilities for the convenience of international students.

RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT CELL

As per the guidelines outlined in NEP-2020 and directions from the UGC, a Research & Development Cell has been established in the University, consisting of the following Committees:

I. Finance & Infrastructure. II. Research Programme Policy Department. III. Collaboration and Community. IV. Product Development, Monitoring, and Commercialization. V. IPR Legal & Ethical Matters.

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the University was established in 2016 and has been working towards the realization of the goals of quality enhancement and sustenance. It continuously strives to develop a system for conscious, consistent, and catalytic action to improve the academic and administrative performance of the University. The aim is to channelize all efforts and measures of the University towards promoting a 'Quality Culture' leading to holistic academic excellence. This is achieved through the involvement of students, parents, teachers, administrative staff, and other stakeholders. The IQAC operates under the Chairmanship of the President, with representation from faculty, administration, alumni, and external experts as its members. It conducts meetings from time to time to discuss various issues and actively engages in matters related to curricular aspects, teaching-learning and evaluation, research/consultancy, student support and progression, examination reforms, etc. In 2022, the IQAC played a major role in several activities aimed at improving the academic and administrative performance of the University: Strengthening the feedback system in the revision of syllabi. Involvement in revising the rules and regulations/guidelines for promoting academic integrity and preventing plagiarism in Madhav University. Collection and compilation of data for participation in NIRF-2022. Monitoring the teaching-learning process through a student feedback system, with data being collected, analyzed, and discussed in the academic bodies of the University. Implementation of "Madhav University Guidelines for Program Outcomes, Program Specific Outcomes, Course Outcomes and their Attainment" in the University. Establishment of a central research and training facility on the campus. Recommendation for the constitution of committees on various issues to promote a quality culture on the campus. Involvement in the ongoing process of implementing an ERP solution for all functional areas of the University for effective e-governance. Establishment of research, training, and innovation hubs including incubation centers for Skill Development, Entrepreneurship, Corporate Resource, and Sports on the University campus.

NSS AND STUDENTS' SUPPORT SERVICES

The University has been working towards accreditation by assessing its progress towards academic excellence across various aspects including Curricular Aspects, Teaching-Learning and Evaluation, Research, Consultancy and Extension, Infrastructure and Learning Resources, Students' Support and Progression, Governance, Leadership, and Management, Innovations, and Best Practices.

To facilitate this, the Office of the Proctor/Dean, Students' Welfare has been established to oversee a range of facilities and opportunities for students. These include cultural, sports, NSS, and Youth Red Cross activities conducted by the University Teaching Departments and Institutes on campus. The office maintains communication with students regarding their needs and other welfare activities, issuing bus and train passes, organizing educational/study tours, and providing support for extension lectures and other student programs. Additionally, the office offers financial assistance to differently-abled students for transportation on campus and supports needy students through the Earn While You Learn Scheme, allowing them to work in their Departments/Institutes on a token payment basis.

ALUMNIASSOCIATION:

The 1st Alumni Meet was conducted on 18.12.2022, with more than one thousand pass-out students participated. They enthusiastically reunited with old colleagues and faculty members, many of whom are now well-placed. The 2nd Alumni Meet was held on 11.10.2023, with about 1000 alumni participated. The event featured a get-together and interaction between new and old students. To entertain the attendees, a renowned Gujarati singer, Ms. Geeta Ben Rebari, was invited, and the audience enjoyed her performance.

WELFARE SCHEMES:

Swachh Bharat Abhiyan: Under the leadership of NSS units, activities such as Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, plantation drives, and awareness campaigns about government policies are conducted. Adoption of villages: The University has adopted five nearby villages, where NSS teams visit to assist villagers with cleanliness and education awareness. Awareness programs are organized with the help of Village Panchayats. Welfare/Social works: I) Free medical checkup camps are organized by the Madhav Hospital Staff, providing free medicines to those in need. II) The University hosts a weekly Bhandara on Tuesdays, feeding over 1000 needy individuals. III) Plans are underway to establish libraries, sewing centers, and computer training facilities in the adopted villages to empower youth and foster self-reliance.

PLACEMENT CELL

- **1.Academia-Industry Interface**: The Placement Cell organizes Executive meets/interaction programs in collaboration of Industry. Few such programs were organized in the reporting year and around 500 students participated in these programmes.
- 2. Employment Information: The Placement Cell provides job related information to the students. This information is displayed on the notice board of the Placement Cell and also on the notice boards placed at different places in the University. The information is also circulated to the concerned departments for the information of students.
- **3. Personality Development:** Placement Cell organizes programs aimed at over all personality development of the university students. These programmes imbibe essential skills in the students and enhance their employability. Sevaral programmes have been organized during the past in the University and many students participated in these Programmes.
- 4. Career Guidance and Counselling, Soft Skills development and Employability Enhancement Training:

The Placement Cell also provides career guidance to the students for their better employment. The Cell helps the students to prepare for different stages of recruitment and selection drive such as resume-writing, group discussions, mock interview etc.

- 5. Entrepreneurship Development: The university has established Entrepreneurship Development Club under the Placement Cell and EDC which organizes Entrepreneurship Development programmes to motive the students for entrepreneurship and self-employments.
- **6. Campus Placements Drives:** The Placement Cell coordinates/organize recruitment drive/campus interviews for university students and more so for the students of professional courses. Several companies/organization have recruited the students and the students have been placed at different level.



CHAPTER-III

RULES FOR ADJUSTMENT AND REFUND OF FEE

(a) ADJUSTMENT OF FEE

If a candidate after having deposited fee for admission in one course joins another course in another University Teaching Dept./Institute in the same session, as mentioned below, and is permitted to withdraw his/her candidature, fee/funds except admission fee already deposited by him/her for the course from which he/she has withdrawn, shall be adjusted/refunded against the fee/funds of the course he/she joins subject to the condition that the difference, if any, shall be paid by the candidate:

- (i) from a general course to another general course;
- (ii) from a general course to any other professional course in order of merit or vice-versa

(b) **REFUND OF FEE**

If a candidate withdraws from the course/programme in which he/she was admitted in the University Teaching Departments//Institutes/College maintained by the Madhav University, the fee to the candidate will be refunded as per following rules:

Note: In case of demise of a candidate during the period as per point no. 1, 2 and 3 above, the application of withdrawal of admission and refund of fee is to be submitted by the parents/guardian of the candidate and the fee will be refunded without any deductions.

*Formally-notified last date of admission is the date of display of the Final List(i.e. the date on which, candidate mark their attendance by physical presence) in the Dept./ Institute/college.

Fee will be refunded to the eligible candidate who are covered the above criteria given at Sr.No.1 to 4 within 30 working days from the date of closure of admission of that academic session. In the courses, which are also governed by AICTE rules, application of refund of fee will not be admitted after 10th of August as last date for completing the admission process is 15th August.

CHAPTER-IV

(i) IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- (I) Download and read it carefully to ensure your eligibility and acquaint with the requirements for submission of Online Application Form, no separate information will be sent to any candidate in this regard. HBI can be downloaded from 'Admission' section available on the website of Madhav University, madhavuniversity.edu.in.
- (II) Candidates have to apply for Admissions 2024 online ONLY by accessing the website/admission portal. Application Forms other than online mode will not be accepted in any case. Only one application for a programme is to be submitted by a candidate. More than one application i.e. multiple application forms submitted for the same programme by a candidate will be rejected.
- (III) Candidates are advised to upload all the relevant documents and testimonials along with their application form for ascertaining their Date of Birth, Eligibility, Category as well as for calculating the Merit for Admission Purpose.
- (IV) Before starting to fill up the on line application, keep ready withyou the following details,

Note:

- (r) The candidates must ensure that they have obtained the relevant certificate(s) from the appropriate competent authority approved.
- (ii) It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to upload all necessary documents/ certificates/ testimonials/fees with the application form. Discrepancy, if any, shall not be communicated to the candidates by the University/department/institute.
- (iii) Not uploading of required documents will be considered as incomplete application form. The same will be identified and rejected for admission by the Admission Committee of the Department.
- (iv) Upload the correct Photograph and Signature as the facility for correction in images will not be given.
- (v) Visit the official website of admission Portal madhavuniversity.edu.in and follow the following procedure:
- (a) Click on'admission' tab.
- (b) Choose your State preference from two available options—Rajasthan and Other State
- (c) Proceed by entering your Aadhar Number/Mobile Number.
- (d) Fill basic details like email, mobile number, name, password etc.
- (e) OTP messages will be sent to your registered email id and mobile number. Applicant is advised to fill up the e-mail ID carefully since the password shall be sent to the applicant'se-mail ID/Mobile Number.
- (f) Now login using use (registered emailI'd) and password.
- (g) Fill the details in the application form carefully.
- (h) Fill other details like education, personal, address etc.

- (I) Upload your pass port sizep hotograph, signature and other documents in the prescribed format as required.
- (j) Select the programme in which you want to apply.
- (k) Now pay the application fee through online mode. Online application registration fee/admission fee for admissions to various programmes shall be deposited by the candidates through all online modes (except debit card/credit card) like Net banking/UPI/RTGS-NEFT/CSC (Common Services Centre) Wallet by using online payment gateway during filling of application forms and at the time of admission. Online registration application fee once paid shall not be **refunded (full or partial)** under any circumstances. The candidates are required to check the status of fee payment at Madhav University website and if the status is "OK", the candidate will be able to take the print out of Confirmation Page.In case, the fee payment status is not"OK",it means that transaction is canceled and the amount will be refunded as per University Rules after completion of admission process. The Application Processing-cum-registration Fee of a programme has been fixed of Rs.5000.
- (1) Take a print out of the filled application form for further uses.

In order to apply in another programme, login using user id and pass word and repeat the above mentioned steps (j) to (l).

(ii) OTHER IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- (1) No programme will be started if the strength of admitted students is less than ten, and no option will be started if the strength is less than five. All the Departments shall notify the options in each programme with number of seats well before the admission and the options will be allotted on merit basis.
- (2) Candidates having compartment in the qualifying examination shall not be allowed admission in the concerned programme.
- (3) Any legal dispute relating to admissionn of students will be subject to Courts at Sirohi Courts having jurisdiction in Sirohi.
- (4) The Madhav University can make use of the data generated, for the purpose of research and analysis.
- (5) MU does not take any responsibility for the candidates not being able to submit their Application Forms by the last date and time on account of any reason beyond the control of the MU. Candidates can check their fee status after login to their account and can download/print the receipt.
- (6) Unless otherwise provided, a person who is eligible to take admission as per conditions laid down in the concerned Ordinance, can pursue two academic programmes simultaneously through Distance Education or Open and Distance Learning(ODL)/Online mode; or upto two ODL/Online programmes or combination of distance and regular modes, from the same or different Universitites/Institutions duly approved by the UGC/AICTE/Central Government/State Governments, in various combinations, viz;
 - (I) A student can persue two full time academic programmes in physical mode provided that in such cases, class timings for one programme do not overlap with the class timings of the other programme.
 - (II) A student can pursue two academic programmes, one in full time physical mode and another in Open and Distance Learning (ODL)/Online mode; or upto two ODL/online programme simultaneously.
- **Note1:** The above programme(s) shall be applicable only to the students pursuing academic programmes other than **Ph.D.** programme.
- **Note2:** The time- table of two full time academic prorammes in physical mode overlap with each other in all the programmes(except evening programmes) therefore, it is not possible for a candidate to pursue two full time academic programmes in physical mode.

- (7) The Deans/Directors of the University Teaching Faculties/ Departments/Institutes to ensure that ineligible candidate(s) is/are not allowed admission in the Dept./Institute and for this every precaution must be taken. Responsibility for any wrong/irregular admission or admission allowed on the basis of fake certificate, in contravention of the Ordinance, if any, will rest entirely with the DeanHead/ of the University Faculty/Teaching Departments/Institutes concerned, admission of such students may be treated as cancelled ab-initio. In case any student files civil suit in any Judicial Court against the orders declaring him/her ineligible, the said civil suit is required to be defended by the UniversityFaculty/Department/ Institutes concerned.
- (8) Every student must follow University rules and regulations in maintaining discipline on the Campus. If a student is found involved in any act/s of indiscipline, unlawfulness or misbehavior and is punished as per University rules, all dues paid by him/her shall be forfeited and no refund will be allowed.
- (9) Nothing contained in this HBI should be construed to convey sanction or be cited as an authority for which University Regulations/Act alone are applicable.
- (10) If the concerned authorities are not satisfied with the character/past behaviour/antecedents of a candidate, they may refuse to admit him/her to anyprogramme of study in the University/Department/Institute/College in order to ensure academic standards, discipline and peaceful atmosphere in the university. The President may cancel the admission of any student for a specified period. (If the Hostel authorities are not satisfied with the character/past behaviour/antecedents of a student, Hostel accommodation may be refused to him/her in order to ensure discipline and peaceful atmosphere of the Hostels.)
- (11) State-wise List of Fake Universities and Examinations of Board not recognized for the purpose of higher studies: List of Fake Universities declared by UGC and Examinations of Board not recognized for the purpose of higher studies by the Board of School Education, Rajasthan, available on their websites. Before finalizing the admissions the updated list of recognized examinations of the UGC and the Board of School Education, Rajasthan is required to be consulted www.ugc.ac.in/page/Fake-Universities.aspx and www.bseh.org.in by the Deans/Heads/Directors of the concerned Departments/Institutes.
- (12) Distance Degrees which are not approved by the Joint Committee of UGC, DEC and AICTE/DEC shall not be considered eligible for admission to M. Tech. programmes.
- (13) Materinity leave upto 45 days may be granted to such women students who are studying in the University Teaching Departments/Institutes/Collegesexcept M.P.Ed., B.P.Ed, D.P.Ed.and C.P.Ed.to complete their education without any gap/hindrance.

 The maternity leave to women students will be granted by the competent authority.

iii. INSTRUCTIONS AFTER ADMISSION

- 1. Each admitted student shall have to furnish Self Declaration by him/her as per specimen and his/her Parent/Guardian as per specimen given at **University website** that he/she was never found guilty of ragging and shall not indulge in any act of ragging at the time of opening of Campus and mark their attendance physically in the class room. At the time of admission every candidate shall be required to give an undertaking of good conduct & behaviour and not to indulge in ragging. If a candidate after his/her admission is found indulging in any kind of ragging, his/her admission is liable to be cancelled.
- 2. For information regarding Syllabus of the programmes, Library services, admission to Hostels, fee concession, scholarships etc. the candidates are advised to contact the Deans/Heads/Principal of the Department/Institute/college concerned.
- 3. If a student fails to attend his/her classes continuously for seven days from the date of commencement of the classes or from the date of admission, his/her admission shall be cancelled.
- 4. If a student remains absent from the class for 14 days or more in a month his/her name will be struck off from the rolls and his/her parents will also be informed.
- 5. Each admitted student whose result of qualifying exam is awaited shall have to furnish an undertaking as per attached that he/she admitted at his/her own instance as his/her result is still awaited. If he/she is not able to pass qualifying exam, he/she will be responsible for the incidental consequences regarding eligibility conditions as per rules. He/she will also not claim any refund of fee etc.

CHAPTER - V

ADMISSION RULES AND PROCEDURE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

1. Introduction

These rules define the procedure for the admission of international students to various courses of Madhav University, Pindwara, Sirohi (Rajasthan). These rules are based on General Guidelines issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC), Association of Indian Universities and Statutory/Regulatory directives issued from time to time.

2. The Office

The Office of Director, International Student shall provide necessary guidance for admission of foreign students to the various courses run in the University. All correspondence related to international students should be addressed to the Office of the Director, International Students, Madhav University, Pindwara, Sirohi (Rajasthan) India.

3. International Students

- i) <u>Foreign Student</u>: Students holding passports issued by foreign countries including Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) who have acquired the nationality of foreign countries.
- ii) Persons of Indian Origin (PIO): PIO shall mean the Persons who are citizens of other countries (except Pakistan and Bangladesh) who at any time held an Indian Passport, or who or either of his parents of any of his grand parents was a citizen of India by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of India or Sec 2 (b) of Citizenship Act, 1955 (Act No. 57 of 1955).
- Non-Resident Indians (NRIs): Only those Non Resident Indian students who have studied and passed the qualifying examinations from schools or colleges in foreign countries will be treated as international students. This will include the students studying in the schools or colleges situated in the foreign countries even if affiliated to the Boards of Secondary, Higher secondary Education or Universities located in India, but will not include students studying in those schools and colleges (situated in India) and affiliated to the Boards Secondary Higher Secondary examinations from Boards or Universities located in foreign countries as external students and Dependents of NRI studying in India will not merit the status of international Students.

4. Documents required for admission of international students

- i) VISA: All the international students shall require a student VISA endorsed to the Madhav University, Pindwara, Sirohi (Rajasthan) for joining the full time courses. Foreign students admitted to Madhav University shall obtain a STUDENT VISA in the name of Madhav University on the basis of admission within one Month from the date of admission for the prescribed duration of the course. A copy of this VISA is to be submitted in the office of Director, international Students, Madhav University Pindwara, Sirohi.
 - Students wishing to join a research programme will require a research VISA endorsed to the Madhav University, Pindwara, Sirohi. The visa should be valid for prescribed duration of the course.
 - VISA is not required for NRI students.
- ii) Certificate from Association of Indian Universities (AIU): The course on which eligibility is relied upon must be included in the list of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU). In case the University/Board is not included in the said list, the candidate has to obtain and submit Equivalence Certificate to this effect from the Association of Indian Universities.

Submission of Equivalence Certificate from AIU is mandatory for foreign nationals. The AIU address is given below:

- Prior Security Clearance: All international students desiring to undertake any research work or join a Ph.D or M. Phil. Programme must obtain prior security clearance from the Ministry of Home Affairs and the approval of Department of Secondary and Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India and this must be on the research visa endorsed to the university or institution concerned.
- iv) Attestation by concerned Embassy/High Commission/Consulate: All attestation must be done by the concerned Embassy/High Commission/Consulate of the relevant country in India. The document without attestation shall be summarily rejected.
- v) Attested Transcripts: Candidate applying from their own country should get their transcripts of certificates attested by the concerned accredited authorized Government Agency and also duly certified by the Indian Embassy or Consulate as the case may be Attested copies of Senior School Certificate/Bachelor's Degree/Master's Degree or equivalent thereof should be attached.
- vi) Character Certificate: A Character Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended alongwith its attestation by the concerned Embassy/High Commission/Consulate should be submitted.
- vii) **Medical Certificate**: All the international students have to undergo the medical examination and get the medical fitness certificate. As per government rules all international students entering India on student visa have to be tested for HIV and will not be given admission if found to be positive.
- viii) Registration in Foreign Regional Registration Office (FRRO): Within 14 days of arrival in India, the international student has to register his name with the police in the Foreigner Regional Registration Office (FRRO) of the local police. For this the following documents shall be submitted by the admitted students to the Office of the Director, International Students:
 - a) Photocopy of the Passport
 - b) Photocopy of the VISA
 - c) Proof of Residence
 - d) Proof of Admission
 - e) Four Passport Size photographs
 - f) HIV Report.
 - I) **Eligibility Qualifications**: International students should fulfill the minimum eligibility condition prescribed for admission as per the requirements of the course applied for. HOWEVER, such candidates shall NOT be required to **undergo the admission entrance test**. In case applications are received in excess against the allotted seats in particular course, **interse** merit will be prepared.
- 5. **Last date for Receipt of Application Form**: Last date for Receipt of Application Form duly completed in all respect will be 31st July of every academic session.
- 6. **Hostel Facilities**: University endeavours to provide hostel facilities to almost all outstation students. Each hostel is provided with indoor and outdoor facilities for games and sports. Recreation facility like T.V. sets is also provided. The detail of hostel fee can be obtained from the offices of Chief Wardens (Boys & Girls Hostels), Madhav University.

- 8. **Cancellation of Admission:** The admitted students should note that his admission stands automatically cancelled if:
 - 1. He/She fails to obtain long term Student/Research Visa in the name of the Madhay University, only from the Indian Embassy in his/her country on the basis of the letter of provisional admission.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- 1. required number i.e. 75%/Council rules, then he/she can be detained from appearing in the examinations.
- 2. A student should always wear his/her ID Card around his/her neck on the Campus. The same should be shown when identity proof is required by the University officials.
- 3. No student will be allowed to enter any office, hostel, library, auditorium, administrative & examination blocks, etc., if he/she fails to show his/her University Identity Card. Students will be allowed to attend cultural programmes, sports events, or other programmes of the University only when they are in possession of their ID cards.
- 4. All the students must fill in the required information correctly in the Students' Information Form. The address and contact numbers of parents should be correct so that they can be contacted in case of any emergency.
- 5. If a student gets accommodation allotted in his/her name in a hostel and allows some other person(s) to stay in his/her allotted room and/or to take meals, in that case the admission of both the students, i.e. the allottee and the illegal occupant, shall be cancelled from the Department/Institute as well as from the hostel without assigning any reason.
- 6. Non-residents of university hostels will not be allowed to stay in the hostels without prior permission of the competent authority. Strict disciplinary action would be taken against the student/s who violate/s this rule.
- 7. Bonafide student desirous of bringing/keeping his/her vehicle in the University Campus would be required to submit self-attested photocopies of the Registration Certificate (RC) of his/her vehicle and the driving licence to the Dean/Director of the Department/Institute and to the Warden of the hostel concerned.
- 8. Students are not allowed to honk horn/s of their vehicles or to play loud music in their vehicles.
- 9. No vehicle with black film/s will be allowed entry in the University premises.
- 10. Students must observe maximum speed limit of 30 km per hour while driving their permitted vehicle on the campus.
- 11. Madhav University is a Ragging Free Campus. All students must follow the University guidelines regarding Anti-Ragging. To report incident/s of any kind of ragging, helpline numbers are displayed at major places on the campus and the University website also.
- 12. All students should behave decently with female students, teachers and employees. No student should involve in any incident of eve-teasing. Anyone found indulging in such activity shall be liable to stringent disciplinary action. The University strictly follows its policy of zero tolerance towards eve-teasing and act/s of sexual harassment.
- 13. Students should use decent language with everyone on the campus.
- 14. The University property should not be harmed in any manner. If a student is found damaging the University property, strict action will be taken against him/her.
- 15. Use of alcohol, tobacco and drugs in any form is strictly prohibited on the University Campus. Every student must observe these instructions on the Campus failing which strict action will be taken against him/her to the extent of expulsion from the University and the course.
- 16. Every student must follow University rules and regulations in maintaining discipline on the campus. If a student is found involved in any act/s of indiscipline, unlawfulness or misbehaviour then he/she will be punished as per University rules.
- 17. No student is allowed to disturb the academic atmosphere of the campus. If anyone is found disrupting classes or instigating students to disrupt classes, then such activity will be considered serious indisciplinary act and the student will be punished accordingly.
- 18. University has a mechanism to redress the grievances of its students through Students' Grievances Redressal Cell. A student can submit his/her complaint/grievance to the Dean Students' Welfare, Convener of the Cell, in writing mentioning his/her name, class, department/hostel & phone number to the office of Dean Students' Welfare/Registrar. Students are advised not to hold any rally or protest near the University administrative block. They should take up the issue, if any, first with the Chairperson/Director/Principal/ Warden/Chief Warden and then with the Dean Students' Welfare.
- 19. Students must obey instructions of the teacher-in-charge(s) while on a tour/ trip/ field training/ Industrial training, etc. All safety norms, as prescribed in the UGC Safety Regulations, should be followed by students on and off the campus.
- 20. All the students must observe silence in the library. They must not use mobile phones in the library.
- 21. One should not write or paste posters on the walls and window panes of the University buildings. Any poster/hoarding found pasted/fixed/hanged at any place, other than the prescribed place, will attract severe punishment under the Defacement Act of Public Property.
- 22. Students are expected to keep the campus neat and clean. The use of polythene is strictly banned on the campus

CHAPTER - VI

ATTENDANCE

CANDIDATES HAVE TO FULFILL THE MINIMUM ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTAS GIVEN IN THE ORDINANCE FOR EACH PROGRAMME

The minimum attendance required for each Semester/year for various programmes unless otherwise provided in the Ordinance of a programme is 75%/Councils' Rules of the full programme of lectures delivered in each Paper, Practical and Tutorials separately.

Note:

Hostel accommodation is compulsory in case of following courses to maintain regularity:

Mandatory to stay in the Hostel for the students of Education, Physical Education & Special Education(All courses), Physiotherapy, Paramedical and Homoeopathy students.

University Authorities make best efforts to provide maximum facilities to the hostellers viz. purified cold water, geyser, common room, LED TV with cable broadcasting facility channels, Newspapers & magazines, First Aid Centre, indoor games, quality food to provide quality atmosphere for effective teaching learning. Facilities of library/reading hall, computer lab, Gym, facilities of washing machines, a common canteen, a guest house for the use of bonafide guests of resident's hostellers, tailoring shop, photocopier shop, general store and dhobi shop are provided additionally in the girls hostel complex for the convenience of the girls residents.

(A) Submission of Admission Forms.

- i. Students seeking admission to the hostel must apply offline/online through University web portal madhavuniversity.edu.in.
- ii. The admission in the hostel will be made through the concerned Dean/Director/Head/Principal of the Faculty/Institute/College. The Dean/Director/Head/Principal will forward list of the students applying for the admission to hostels strictly on the basis of distance from the residence and academic merit. The distance will be measured from the residential address city/village as mentioned in the Admission Form and on the basis of Residential Proof.
- iii. Incorrect information in the Application Form /Leave Form will be considered as misconduct and will invite disciplinary action or expulsion from the hostel.
- iv. A student, suffering from an infectious disease will not be allowed to stay in the hostel till he/she produces a certificate of medical fitness of non-infectious from the R.M.O. of the University Hospital or Civil Surgeon/CMO.

(B) Eligibility for admission.

- i. No student shall be admitted to the University Hostels beyond a period of duration of two academic courses in different sessions to which he/she has been admitted as regular student.
- ii. Admission is to be sought afresh for each Academic Session subject to the satisfaction of the Warden/Chief Warden regarding proper conduct and regular payment of dues of hostel, mess and canteen etc.
- iii. No employee of the University or any other Organization/Office/Department joining any course in the University without obtaining leave from his/her employer, for the total duration of the course will be allowed accommodation in any of the University Hostels.
- iv. Hostel accommodation is not provided to any student having permanent residence within a radius of 30 kms for Boys and 20 kms for Girls from the University Campus. However, the accommodation, relaxing this criteria, may be provided to the needy and deserving students on valid grounds with prior permission of the Chief Warden/Warden.

(c) Allotment of hostel accommodation.

- i. All rights of admission to the University hostels are reserved with the concerned Chief Warden. Hostel accommodation will be allotted on the recommendation of the Deans/Heads/Directors/ Principals of respective Teaching Department/Institute if the applicant is otherwise eligible. Any of the rules contained in this rule book can be changed without prior notice.
- ii. Rooms will be allotted by the concerned Warden subject to the approval by the respective Chief Warden/authorized Officer.
- iii. Admission to hostel will be cancelled if the student fails to take possession of the room within a period of 15 days and fee will be refunded as per rules applicable.
- iv. 3% seats of hostel accommodation are reserved for Differently Abled Students and 20% seats are reserved for SC/ST students.
- v. A resident cannot shift from his/her allotted room without the permission of the Hostel Warden.
- vi. Differently Abled Persons /Pregnant Women will be allotted accommodation preferably on ground floor. They can share their room with a friend who can help them to manage their daily routine.
- vii. If the hostel authorities are not satisfied with the character, past behavior and antecedents of a student, then the hostel authority may refuse accommodation to him/ her in order to ensure discipline and peaceful atmosphere of the hostels.

- 1.In case a student is eligible for two scholarships at a time, he/she will get only one scholarship whichever is higher. Further, the student is availing any Government scholarship, he/she will not be eligible for any scholarship of MU.
- 2. Students not complying to any one of the above-mentioned requirements for subsequent years his/her scholarship will be cancelled with immediate effect.
- 3. A Student whose Scholarship is cancelled once will not be entitled for continuation of the scholarships.
- 4. Student will be given Scholarship if he/she fulfills the desired eligibility. The continuation of scholarship for subsequent years will be subject to (a) Minimum 7.5 CGPA in the previous year examination; (b) Minimum attendance of 75% in each semester (previous session); (c) No backlog in the previous year Exams; and (d) No disciplinary action against student in the previous session.
- 5. Candidates who are awarded the scholarship on the basis of student applications would be communicated at the time of admission and the scholarship amount would be refunded on deposition of course fee.
- 6. A student needs to submit all required documents at the time of submitting his application. The decision of admission will be on the basis of submitted documents. No documents would be asked individually.
- 7. Preference in admissions and award of scholarships is subject to approval of the competent authority. This is applicable to all the relevant scholarships.
- 8. Award of all the scholarships is subject to approval of the competent authority.
- 9. In case of any dispute, the decision of the President of the University would be final and binding.

CHAPTER - IX

- d. Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- e. Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students;
- f. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students:
- g. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: in sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- h. Any act or abuse by spoken words, e-mails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture of rashers or any other student;
- i. Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.
- j. Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student(fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.


