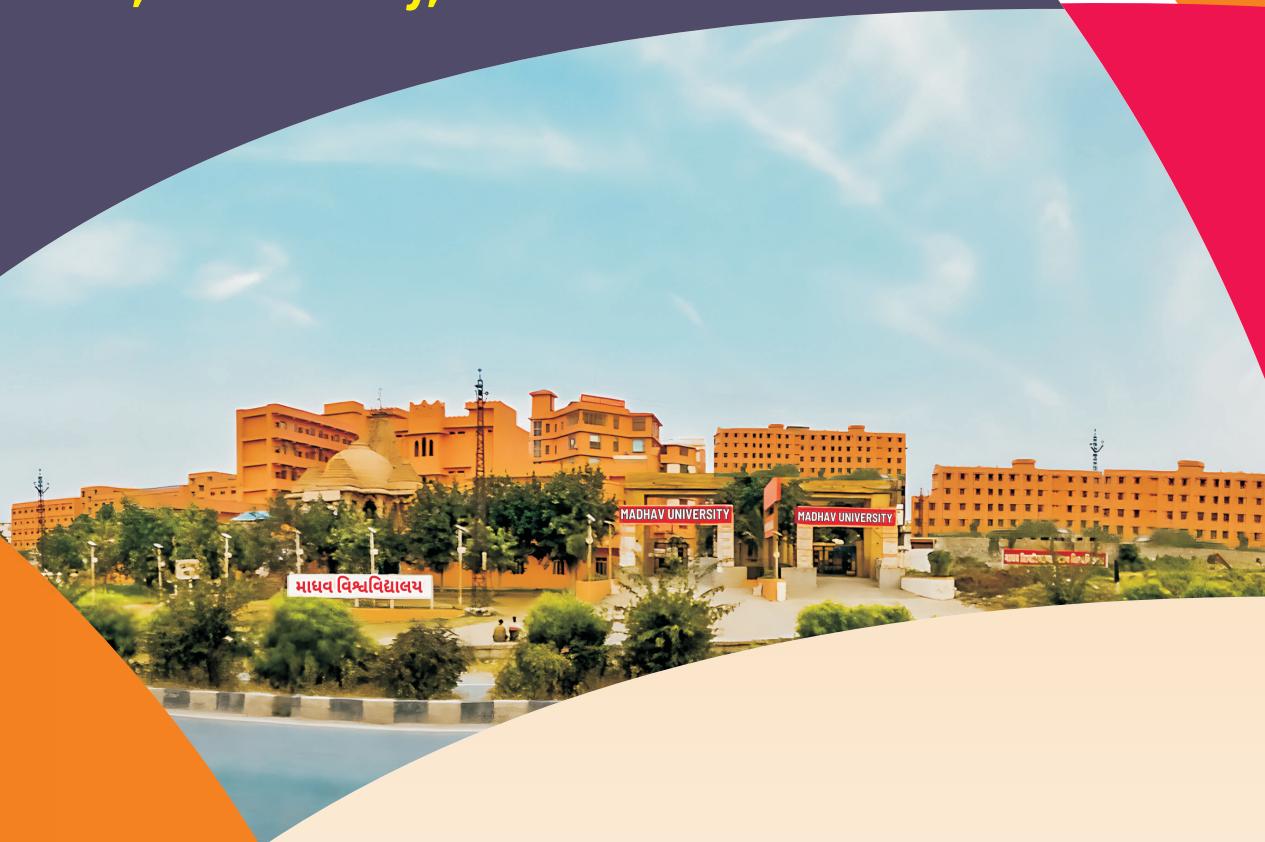

- Use A4 page size, single spaced, 12-point Times New Roman font and Mangal Font.
- Minimum word limit 2500 words & Maximum word limit of 3000 - 3500 words per Research Paper.
- Kindly include the author's full name, designation, affiliations, email, & Mobile Number. Research Papers must be written in English/Hindi for acceptance in the conference. Citation Style & Referencing Guide (APA 7th Edition)
- Upto 10% plagerism is allowed in the papers more than that will lead to rejection of the paper.
